Dear Senator Webb:

This is in reply to the letter from you and fellow Senators regarding a possible increase in the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Beneficiary Travel Program mileage reimbursement rate.

As you wrote in your letter and as I previously testified during my confirmation hearing, the 11 cents a mile rate is an inadequate reimbursement for travel. Therefore, effective February 1, 2008, VA is raising its mileage reimbursement rate to 28.5 cents a mile. This much needed increase will assist in defraying the costs incurred by veterans who travel significant distances for VA care.

A similar letter has been sent to the cosigners of your letter. I thank you and your colleagues for your leadership and attention to this issue and look forward to working with you this next year on behalf of our Nation's veterans.
